5. What was unusual about the prisoner in charge of their barracks?
6. The next day, the prisoners underwent a last step in their admission process. What was it?
7. Who did Elie meet after several days at the camp?
8. What did Stein want?
9. How did Elie respond to Stein's request for information?

10. Since the prisoner in charge of their block was kind, and since there was no work to be done, Elie and his father tried to avoid being transported anywhere else. How were they able to avoid being transported?
