Phylacteries:

Judaism. either of two small, black, leather cubes containing a piece of parchment inscribed with verses 4–9 of Deut. 6, 13–21 of Deut. 11, and 1–16 of Ex. 13: one is attached with straps to the left arm and the other to the forehead during weekday morning prayers by Orthodox and Conservative Jewish men.

Surreptitiously

acting in a stealthy way.

Surreal:

having the disorienting, hallucinatory quality of a dream; unreal; fantastic

Conflagration:

a destructive fire, usually an extensive one.

Partisans:

an adherent or supporter of a person, group, party, or cause, especially a person who shows a biased, emotional allegiance

Inhibitions:

Constraints

Irrevocably:

not to be revoked or recalled; unable to be repealed or annulled; unalterable

Hermetically:

so as to be airtight: hermetically sealed.
