Colic: paroxysmal pain in the abdomen or bowels.

Wizened: withered; shriveled: a wizened old man; wizened features.

Veritable: true, as a statement or tale

Altruistic: unselfishly concerned for or devoted to the welfare of others

Pittance: a small amount or share.
