Din: a loud, confused noise; a continued loud or tumultuous sound; noisy clamor.

Chinks: a crack, cleft, or fissure

Amputated: to cut off (all or part of a limb or digit of the body), as by surgery.

Dysentery: an infectious disease marked by inflammation and ulceration of the lower part of the bowels, with diarrhea that becomes mucous and hemorrhagic.

Annihilate: to reduce to utter ruin or nonexistence; destroy utterly

Knell: the sound made by a bell rung slowly, especially for a death or a funeral.
